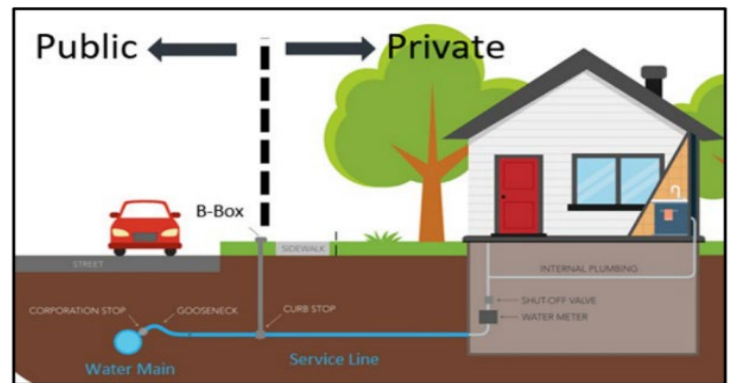
**ONLINE HOME SURVEY
WATER SERVICE MATERIAL INVENTORY**

The Village of Elburn is required by law to inventory water service line material within the Village’s community water system and report their findings to the State. The main purpose of this inventory is to determine the number and location of water services constructed with lead.

General Information:

Structures built prior to 1986 may have a water service line constructed with lead. If your home or business has a lead water service line, this does NOT mean you automatically have lead in your water. There are several factors that can contribute to lead dissolving into the water from the lead service line or lead plumbing. The amount of lead will vary depending on how much water is used in your home and how often it is used. Please note lead is NOT found in the Village’s water source and it is NOT found in the Village’s treated drinking water.

New regulations pertaining to lead water services cover both the publicly owned side of the service (water main to exterior shut off valve) and the privately owned side of the service (exterior shut off valve to the interior water meter). Based on current regulations, property owners are not required to replace their portion of the lead service line.



Resident Online Survey

Enclosed in an exhibit showing all homes or businesses likely built prior to 1986 and therefore may have a lead water service line. You are receiving this letter because your property is highlighted on the exhibit.

The Village needs your help. We respectfully request you take an online survey that describes how to properly identify your water service line material in 3 easy steps. The survey should take less than 10 minutes. We ask that the person living in the home fill out the survey, even if they are not the property owner. Owners of rental properties within the project limits have also received a copy of this letter.
