Subject: 2022 Streets Program – Potential Additional Expense

SAP: STR-2 Identify strategies for wastewater (and stormwater) conveyance from the north side to enhance capacity allowing for development of the north side of the Village

At the July 18, 2022 meeting, the Village Board discussed the potential of installing sanitary sewer and storm sewer on a portion of E Pierce Street (between 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Streets—see attached map) that is currently served by city water but no sanitary (currently on individual septic systems) or storm sewers. Since this area is included in the 2022 Streets Program, the Board is considering the additional cost to install sanitary and storm sewers in advance of the street replacement.

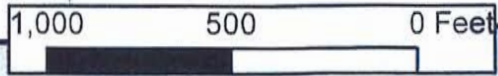
In addition to the cost for the Village to install the sanitary and storm sewer, the Village Board asked for a realistic cost estimate to individual homeowners to transition from a septic system to municipal sanitary sewer.

At press time, the estimate is still being compiled and will be provided to the Board at their meeting on Monday evening, August 1, 2022.
