1. Call to Order – Chairman Marshall called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance – Chairman Marshall led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Roll Call – A roll call ensued.
4. Public Comments – None
5. Police Department – Chief Sikora reported there are test results to present to the Commission for consideration.
6. Executive Session – The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of specific employees of the public body [5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1)] – At 5:02pm, Miller motioned to leave regular session and enter into executive session. The motion was seconded by Marshall. A roll call vote ensued. Ayes: Marshall, Miller. Nays: None. Motion carried.

A motion to leave executive session and re-enter regular session was made by Miller at 5:18pm. The motion was seconded by Marshall. A roll call vote ensued. Ayes: Marshall, Miller. Nays: None. Motion carried.

7. Motion/Approve to Extend Final Job Offer(s) for Full-time Officer Position(s) – A motion to extend a final job offer to candidate Jesus Loza was made by Miller and seconded by Marshall. A roll call vote ensued. Ayes: Marshall, Miller. Nays: None. Motion carried. Chief Sikora had Chairman Marshall sign the official offer letter. Chief Sikora will contact Loza with the news.

When asked, Chief Sikora said Elburn currently has 11 full-time and 9 part-time officers. With the new Statutes regarding mandatory training, it is difficult for some part-time officers to meet the requirements. Some part-time officer resignations are expected after Elburn Days. Chief Sikora supports the training requirements and appreciates help from the State to enforce.

8. Motion/Approve to Strike Candidate(s) from the Eligibility List – This item was not discussed.

9. Other Business – Use of drones during Elburn Days was discussed. Village Attorney Thomas will review State Statutes regarding their use and will report back to the Police Department.

The next meeting is scheduled for August 25, 2022 at 5:00pm.

10. Adjournment - Miller motioned to adjourn the meeting at 5:30p.m. with Marshall seconding the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous voice vote.
