MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2022 at 7 AM

1. Call to Order at 7:14 am
2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Roll Call: All present -- John Marshall, Judy Miller, Addam Gonzales
4. Public Comments: None
5. Executive Session: Prior to a Motion to Enter Executive Session, the Commissioners unanimously agreed to change two of the Oral Interview Questions, and add one, as follows:

“How would you respond if someone offered you a bribe?” was changed to “How would you respond if you and your partner are in downtown Elburn at night and noticed the door of the Candy Store ajar, and your partner steals a candy bar?”

“If a friend or a relative commits an illegal act or crime, how would you handle it?” was changed to “If you were on duty and saw a car swerving on Rt. 47 and pulled it over, and found it was your mother, how would you handle it?”

The new question that was added reads, “If you are on patrol and you come around a corner and see a person with a bat standing over someone on the ground, what would you do?”

Having made the changes to the Oral Interview Questions, and having reviewed the candidate files, a Motion to Enter Executive Session was made by John Marshall and seconded by Addam Gonzales. All in favor. Executive Session opens at 7:31 am.
